## Notes

1. The published times are the actual writing times. You should aim to get to the exam at least 10 minutes before the start time shown. If you arrive late, you may find that any work completed in extra time will not be marked - this will be the decision of the exam board.
2. Seating is always arranged in candidate number order. This usually agrees with the surname order – but not always!
3. Do not bring a bulky pencil case to exams. You must keep any pens, pencils, etc. in a clear polythene sandwich bag or transparent pencil case. You are not permitted an opaque pencil case, spectacles case or calculator lid on your desk.
4. It is your responsibility to correctly record your candidate and centre number on every piece of paper you use. You must also secure any extra sheets you use to the answer booklet you have written in.
5. There are occasions when two or more units are being taken in the same session. Candidates may not be taking all the units. Everyone should arrive for the official start time and leave after they have completed the appropriate exams.
6. For some exams we will be using a number of different rooms. Make sure you go to the correct venue.
7. If you do not attend an exam or fail to complete coursework, the exam board will require a satisfactory explanation. Without an explanation, the board will either fail you completely in that subject, or give you 0% for whatever you missed. Usually, the only acceptable excuse is **illness supported by a medical note signed by a doctor**. It is the candidates' responsibility to advise Mr. Bolton of their excuse as soon as possible and provide any note. Please indicate which subject/dates where you feel you underachieved.
8. Exam boards have made it clear that they will take action against any candidate taking unauthorised equipment (mp3/mobile phone/walkman etc.) into exams. Anyone caught runs the risk of disqualification in all subjects irrespective of whether any disturbance was caused.
9. Exam venues are heated but January can be a very cold month, please dress appropriately.
10. A copy of this timetable will be on display in the Reception Area's throughout the exam period.
11. Results for January 2010 Exams will be available on 11th March 2010.
